Games are catered for where ever possible by either the Clubhouse or the Chukka Bar which serve hot and cold drinks, sandwiches and snacks.

We do ask also that you do not enter the pony lines at anytime.

You will always be able to park your car at Kirtlington but please take care not to park in the pony lines or near horse boxes.
